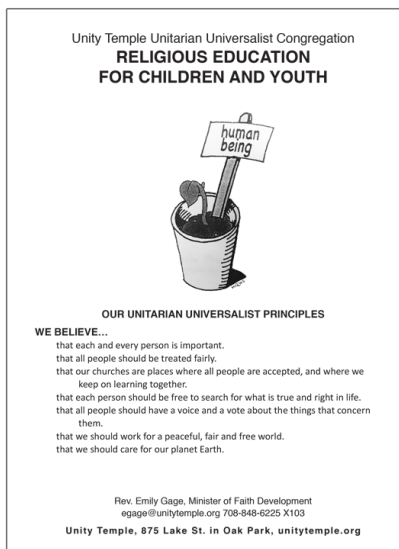

Our young people will know:

- Unitarian Universalist faith, history and heritage
- The value of sacred stories and leaders from other faith traditions
- That meaning comes from many sources
- Their own self worth, and manifest this in healthy relationships
- Their actions make a difference in this world

Our young people will feel:

- Committed to Unitarian Universalism
- Called to act out of love, not fear
- Valued and have ownership in their UU community
- Part of something larger than themselves
- Hope, beauty and inspiration in our worship

Our young people will be:

- Able to draw strength and comfort in times of grief from themselves and others.
- Accepting of their own and life's limitations
- Open and willing to engage with others in an ongoing quest for truth and meaning.
- Loving, caring and kind
- Engaged in developing their own ongoing spiritual practice

Our religious education classes for children and youth take place during the worship service. Those kindergarten and up begin in the worship service, then leave for their classes, so they maintain a connection with the larger community. Nursery care and preschool are also provided concurrently with our worship service.

We also have regular scheduled worship for all ages and faith in action for all ages throughout the program year. Visitors are welcome.
